Camper Hook up \$80.00 Friday 10 am thru Sunday end of show. Monday departure must be approved by show management prior to show, stall and camper hookup usage will incur extra fees.

Show Info and Rules:

- *Flat Fee Entries-Must include competed Flat Fee form, Entry form, required signatures, copies of registration papers/membership cards (if entering breed classes) and full payment. See Flat Fee and Stall Info for stall reservation and refund policies.
- *Health Paperwork: FOR ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS a valid Coggins certificate (if drawn in NYS dated 2023 or 2024, drawn outside of NYS dated 5/20/23 or later) and Rabies certificate dated 5/20/23 or later must be provided to the show office. Vet office receipts are not suitable proof, legible certificates only accepted. Electronic copies will be accepted by email if they meet all criteria.
- *Any refunds issued will be done by check within 30 days of the last day of the show.
- *All stabling groups of 3 or more horses must turn in a split sheet before any back numbers in that group will be released.
- *Camper/Trailers hooking up to electric and/or water must be parked in designated areas. All campers/trailers must register at the office and receive a paid tag to be displayed on the unit hooked up. Any camper/trailer parked in the camping area will be charged a hook up fee regardless if connected or not. Campers not displaying proper tag run risk of being unplugged.
- *General Schooling: AQHA equipment and animal welfare rules will be followed at all times in the schooling, trailer and stabling areas; it is the exhibitor's responsibility to be aware of these rules.
- *All-Breed WTJ classes: WTJ open to any age/experience horse and exhibitor, any horse/rider combo entered in All-Breed WTJ classes cannot enter any class requiring a lope or canter.
- *All-Breed Open classes: Open to any horse/pony regardless of breed/registration status and any age rider, will be run WTC/WJL.
- * Non-negotiable Checks: A \$20 service charge plus bank fees, postage, other expenses & the face value of the check on any non-negotiable check due payable with cash or certified funds within 10 days of notification. Legal action taken after 30 days. Anyone with a bad check to Winning Weekends within the past 2 years will have entries processed on a CASH or CERTIFIED funds basis ONLY.
- *Dogs must be leashed/crated at all times and dogs cannot be left unattended in barn aisles. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be available for inspection.
- *SHOW OFFICE will be closed for 20 minutes following the completion of last class on Sunday to allow for calculation of awards. Please make sure to check out prior to this time. All Weekend awards will be announced 20 minutes following the final class in that division. We appreciate your understanding to not ask the show office staff for results prior to that time.
- *Per NYS VAT laws #1265, all youth under 18 are required to wear an ASTM approved helmet whenever mounted. It is the parent/guardians responsibility to enforce this.
- *ALL HORSES on the grounds (shown or not) must be registered with the show office and present a valid coggins and rabies certificate.
- *General Policies: No Smoking in any buildings. Please obey all no parking and fire lane signs. Horses should not to be tied to any fences/barns and must be bathed at the wash racks provided. Motorized vehicles: golf carts or any other motorized vehicles may only be operated by licensed drivers and will be impounded if operated in an irresponsible or reckless manner. ABSOLUTELY NO OPEN FIRES allowed at any times on the show grounds. ***Failure to follow any of these fairground policies after initial warning will result in removal from the grounds for entire stabling group found in violation with NO REFUNDS issued***
