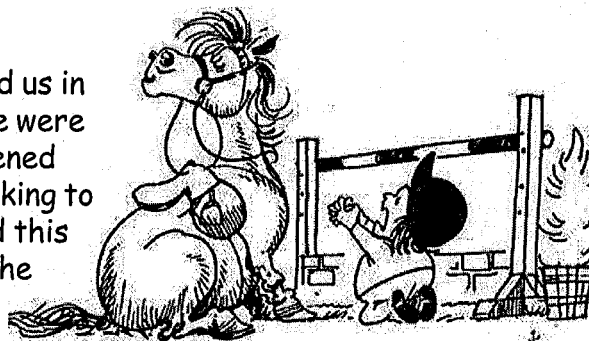

Take New York Thruway North to exit 25A, which is I-88. Take I-88 to Exit 22 (the first Cobleskill Exit) Turn left after the ramp and turn right onto County Road 1 (also known as Mineral Springs Road). Turn Right onto Grand Street and Fairgrounds in on the right.

Directions from Binghamton NY/Pennsylvania: Follow I-88 East to Exit 21 (it is also marked for SUNY Cobleskill). Bear to the left to Route 7. Turn right and follow Route 7 to County Road 1 (also known as Mineral Springs Road) go to Grand street, turn left and Fairgrounds is on the right.

Directions from the Western NY state area:

Take New York Thruway East to the Canajoharie exit and then get onto Route 10. Follow it South, turn right onto North Grand Street and it will bring you directly into the village of Cobleskill. At the red light in the center of the village, go straight across Main Street to South Grand Street and the Fairgrounds is on the left after you go under a railroad underpass.

Measuring

Show Guidelines & Rules for 2021 Events



Measuring starts one hour before show time, and by special request, whenever possible throughout the day. Measuring will be conducted by the Show Steward. At the time of measurement, please have available your registration papers, rabies certificate, and a current negative Coggins for each horse to be shown. All horses must be measured before entering their first class. Measuring will take place on the cement pad next to the Race Horse Office by the track. Show Steward Virginia Groen (NY) 607-522-4950.

- All classes are open to everyone meeting the criteria listed for the class - you need not be an affiliated club member to participate!** This show is accredited and conducted under the 2021 rules and regulations of the AMHR/ASPC/ASPR. Rulebooks are available on-line at the Official website of the American Miniature Horse Association & the American Shetland Pony Club or with the official show steward for inspection.
- All horses/ponies must be registered with AMHR/ASPC/ASPR. All horses/ponies must be measured by the AMHR/ASPC/ASPR steward or present a measurement slip documenting measurement by an official AMHR/ASPC/ASPR steward within the last 60 days or a permanent measurement card for miniatures 3 years & older showing one measurement in year 2021. Youth and/or amateur numbers must be provided.
- Youth and Amateur exhibitors must hold current AMHR/ASPC Youth or Amateur cards, or may apply with the show steward for 'pending' status on the day of the show. Please include your youth and amateur numbers on the entry form, and enclose a **COPY OF YOUR CURRENT YOUTH AND AMATEUR CARDS WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM**. Amateurs must also **SIGN** the entry form where indicated. Youth are those youth 18 years & under as of January 1, 2021. Any youth that **aged out** in 2020 is still eligible as a youth in 2021.
- Gelding Status:** It must be reflected on the registration papers in order for the horse to be shown.
- Leased Equines:** They must be on record with the AMHR/ASPC. Include a copy of the Lease Authorization form, and indicate on your entry that the horse is leased.
- Driving Horses: ALL driving equines are to be driven with a bit.
- PA System:** The PA system will be used to make trailer parking calls. However, this is a courtesy provided by the facility. If it does not function, show management will work with the facility to ensure this service, but it is not guaranteed. We will be using a two-minute gate call. Please check in with the gate manager when arriving at the ring so that the show can continue at a steady pace. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to be at the gate on time. Should a tack change be required please request this at the gate at least five classes ahead of the needed time.

- Horse Show Awards: PREMIUMS:** Ribbons will be awarded for first through sixth place **ONLY** in Junior Exhibitor/Youth Classes. All other class winners will receive national points **ONLY**.
- Entries/Fees:** Please Pre-enter if possible. Pre-Entries must be in the secretary's hand by Monday July 19th at the latest. Entries mailed or emailed **AFTER** July 19th are subject to an additional \$25 per horse. Pre-entries must be accompanied with payment. We prefer payment by check payable to Classic Country Horse Association. However, you may charge your entries by credit card, or our show manager will accept "friends & family" option via paypal. Fees: indicated on entry form. All entries must include all necessary signatures, amateur/youth numbers (if applicable) copies of **BOTH SIDES** of your horse/pony Registration papers, copies of health paperwork and **must include** payment. Entries received without payment will be charged post entry fee. Post entries accepted at the show as indicated on entry form.

Classes must be paid for as entered or a signed blank check left at the entry booth. Office Fee of \$10 per each horse and grounds fee of \$10/day for non-stabled showing equines.
- Health Paperwork:** All entries must have a legible, current New York State (2020 or '21) coggins (for equines 6 months of age or older) or 2021 Coggins and current annual rabies certificate available for inspection before back numbers are issued. Coggins & Rabies certificate **MUST** be legible - if we can't read it, you will not be allowed to show - no exceptions. Out of State equines are required to be transported with a health certificate (Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection) within 30 days of the show. Proof of rabies vaccination for equines 4 months of age or older from date of event.
- Each entry form must have the **release statement signed** by the exhibitor or a parent or legal guardian if the exhibitor is under 18 years of age. Failure to wear the correct number in a class or to sign the release statement will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees for that class and forfeiting all awards.

13. The show committee reserves the right to change, move, combine, add or cancel classes as warranted, decline or refuse an entry at this show without being held liable; eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or equine should the best interest of the show be served. **Corrections to the prize list will be posted in the secretary's stand.** The horse show **judges' decision is final** and he/she has the right to dismiss any entry displaying unruliness or unsoundness. All inquires to the judge must be made through the show office. Exhibitors or agents making inquires directly to the judge will be disqualified and no refunds issued. Please request tack holds from the announcer. Evidence of any inhumane treatment to a horse in or out of the show ring will result in disqualification of that horse and that exhibitor for the balance of the show, as well as all of that horse's and exhibitor's points, ribbons, and trophies. All entry, stall, and office fees will be forfeited.
14. Returned Checks: A \$50 charge for nonnegotiable checks if payment is made within 7 days of notification, \$75 thereafter. This is in addition to any bank fees, collection fees and the value of the check. Participation in future events will be barred until outstanding fees are paid. Exhibitors with nonnegotiable checks will have checks posted at the show as well as in future prize lists. According to the NYS General Obligations Law, Section 11-104: if your check bounces you could be liable for the face value of the check, plus two times the amount of the check, up to \$400 for a check dishonored due to insufficient funds, and up to \$750 for checks drawn on a nonexisting account. Bad check writers may also face criminal penalties.
15. Refunds: Pre-entry stall (or pre-entry grounds fees) and class fees will be refunded, only if a request in writing and an authentic veterinary certificate are received by show manager no later than 6 P.M. on show day. All other fees are nonrefundable. All entered classes will be charged to the exhibitor regardless of scratches. Any changes to classes, exhibitor or equine will be treated as a new entry.
16. Age: Exhibitors/Equine age is as of January 1, 2021. All riders 17 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) Equestrian Standard per NY State Law No. VAT1265.
17. Stalls - exhibitors must post the index card on the DOOR of stall and/or camper that the club provides. **Stalls available THURSDAY after 2:00 PM at \$35/stall until SATURDAY at 7am.** If you would like to stay after 7am Saturday, **an additional \$35/stall** will be charged until Sunday at 12 midnight. (and must be vacated within 2 hours of the conclusion of the show unless other arrangements with show management have been made) **Stalls will NOT be rented for one day.** If you are found without your stall door tagged, you will be charged double. Bedding is not provided. **Stalls assigned through show secretary.** All manure must be placed in designated area. You may show off your trailer by paying the unstabled fee of \$10/day per equine. There is NO LIMIT to the number of equines you put in box stalls.
18. Campers - \$65/ (starting after 2pm on Thursday thru Saturday 7am). If you would like to stay after 7am Saturday an additional \$65/camper hookup will be charged until Sunday at 12 midnight. If you need to stay longer, please make arrangements with show manager. **IF YOU PLUG IN YOU WILL BE CONSIDERED A "CAMPER".** Exhibitors must post the index card (club provides) on the DOOR of your camper. If you are found without your Camper tagged, you will be charged double. Failure to pay camper fee will result in forfeiture of points/awards for event. All campers must follow Cobleskill Agricultural Society's camping rules. **If you plug in pay camper fee. If you run a lead cord from one camper to another, you will be charged double for BOTH.** Fairground Camper rules include: Camping limited to event participants on first come first serve bases and must park in designated areas. No one under 18 allowed to stay in a camper without adult supervision. All holding tanks must be closed. No dumping of waste water (gray water) throughout the time the camper is on the grounds. Gas/charcoal grills must be in designated grilling areas. No open flames of any kind in camping areas. No tents allowed in stalls; no one is allowed to sleep in stalls. A separation distance of at least 10 feet must be maintained between camping units, including any add-on structures attached to the camping units including awnings and any structure. The camper registrant is responsible for any fine or violation imposed by the County Health Department. Limited electric hookups available. No generators are provided.
19. Other: Dogs on the show grounds must be leashed/restrained at all times. For safety purposes, dogs should not be near the show ring or gate areas. Owners of aggressive or nuisance dogs (as determined by show management) will be asked to remove them from the show grounds. No entry fees will be refunded. No dogs to be housed in stalls.

Non-showing Equines: Any horse on the grounds but not entered in a class will be charged \$5 for each day on the grounds plus grounds fee or stall fee. Coggins & Rabies will be checked, a release must be signed and if using a stall, stall fee must be paid.
